Dear Parents:

Thank you for your interest in our Summer Camp program. We offer summer camp care for children who will be entering kindergarten thru 8th grade.

- ♥ There is a \$50 **non-refundable** registration fee. This fee needs to be paid as soon as possible to guarantee a spot in our program. Children currently enrolled have first option to available spots in our program. Once capacity is reached, your child may be placed on a waiting list.
- ♥ There is a \$160 activity fee that is due by the first day of summer camp. The activity fee covers field trips & activities during the summer with the exception of special field trips which may include but are not limited to: Lazy 5 Ranch in Mooresville, the Natural Science Museum in Greensboro, the Train Museum in Spencer and the Life and Science Center in Durham. If you choose not to pay the activity fee at the beginning of the summer, field trips & activities will be charged on an individual basis. The cost for each field trip or activity can be found on the Fee Schedule of Field Trips included in the Summer Camp packet.
- ♥ Our hours of operation are 7 am until 6 pm. Our doors close at 6 pm. If you are late picking up your child, your child's account will be charged a \$1/minute late fee. If you are habitually late, the late fee goes to \$5/minute. We reserve the right to dismiss a child from our program for late pick up.
- ♥ Tuition for **full time** campers is \$95 per week w/paid registration fee or \$105 per week without paid registration and must be paid for the weeks you sign your child up for regardless of attendance. Tuition is due on Monday of the week your child attends. If tuition for the week is not received by 6:00 pm on Monday, a **\$10 late fee** will be applied to your child's account.

Tuition for **part-time** campers by the day is \$25 per day w/paid registration fee or \$30 per day without paid registration. Tuition for half day (5 hours or less) is \$15 per day with paid registration or \$20 per day without paid registration. If you choose to pay by the day or half day, tuition is due by 6:00 pm on the day your child attends. If tuition is not received by 6:00 pm of the day your child attends, a **\$10 late fee** will be applied to your child's account.

If your child's account becomes more than a week behind, your child will be dismissed from the program until the account is current. Payments may be dropped in the payment box by the Children's Ministries office or mailed to the address above. If you have questions regarding finances, please contact our Financial Director, Angie Allmond, at 563-3444.

- ♥ If your check is returned by your bank, a \$25 returned check fee will be charged to your account. After 1 returned check, all fees must be paid by money order, certified bank check or cash.

- ♥ We provide a morning and afternoon snack. The past two years we have participated in the USDA Food Program. We are scheduled to participate again this year. If something changes and we do not get to participate, a bag lunch and drink will need to be provided by you for your child every day. Please limit what we must heat because we have only one microwave. A sandwich, piece of fruit and vegetable/chips, along with a drink, are sufficient for most children.
- ♥ Children should wear weather appropriate clothing. Weather permitting we are outside. No halter tops, tank tops with straps less than 1 1/2 inches wide, or any tops that only have strings to hold them on will be permitted.
- ♥ Bathing suits should fit appropriately. For girls this means one piece or tankinis and boys should wear swim trunks. No Speedo's will be allowed. Sunscreen should be applied before the child arrives on swimming day. Children will need a towel and a change of clothes to change into after swimming, including underwear and socks. Flip flops are only allowed to be worn to the pool and must be changed out of after returning from the pool. Children must wear shoes that can be tied or sandals that can be strapped to their feet.
- ♥ We have blue rubber mulch on our playground and the color can get on shoes and clothing. It will wash out; however, you may send in old shoes for your child to change into. Please do not allow your child to wear shoes with wheels in them. The wheels are causing damage to the floors and children are getting hurt when the wheels catch on anything.
- ♥ Please sign your child in and out each day. This is for safety purposes. If someone other than the regular pick-up person is coming for your child, please let us know by note or by calling 919-563-3444 and leaving a message. We check I.D.s.
